



2008 ISSMC GREATEST SUBGUN RAIDS IN HISTORY!



That's right! Its time for the 2008 ISSMC. This year we will be "reenacting" the two of the greatest Subgun Raids of all time... The Raid on Entebbe and the GSG-9 Raid on the Lufthansa airliner in Somalia. Both heavily used submachine guns in a counter-terrorist action – based on surprise and fast action.

The dates for this year's shoot are **June 7th and 8th** at the Old Trails Rifle & Pistol Club in Richmond IN. This year there will be two stages and as usual the shoot will begin each day with a mandatory range briefing at 8:30 am. **If you do not attend the morning briefing you do not shoot!**

The shoot will be limited to 150 runs, 90 on Saturday and 60 on Sunday. Due to continued demand for limited spaces, no shooter this year will be allowed more than three runs total, and no more than 2 per day. We will be using the same classes as previous years:

- Modern** – All non C&R submachine guns w/o optics – mags limited to 30 rounds
- Classic** – All C&R eligible submachine guns w/o optics – mags limited to 30 rounds
- Open** – All submachine guns, optics allowed, no limit on mag capacity.
- Thompson** - All Thompson submachine guns, no optics, any original Thompson mag in 20, 30 or 50 / 100 round drum

Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 shooters in each class so practice! You may only shoot for trophies or ranking in each class on your first run. All guns must be shot in Full Auto Only, no burst or semi-auto.

REMEMBER – space is limited. Last year the shoot sold out in less than 3 days. We must have your sign-up sheet and full payment to secure your spot unless you were a winner in our email trivia game... you know who you are!

The address for the Old Trails Rifle & Pistol Club is 501 Beeson Road, Richmond, IN 47374 for those needing to fill out 5320s. Use MapQuest or Google to get directions. Once again we will be "reenacting" two of the greatest subgun raids of all time...

The Raid on Entebbe: Known as Operation Thunderbolt, the IDF carried out a hostage-rescue mission at Entebbe airport on the night of July 3rd, 1976. On June 27th Air France flight 139 was hijacked carrying 248 passengers and a crew of 12 as it left Athens heading for Paris. Two Palestinians and two Germans commandeered the flight and headed for Libya. It was there for 7 hours to refuel and then on to Entebbe airport in Uganda.



At Entebbe the four hijackers were joined by three additional terrorists – led by Bose. They demanded the release of 40 Palestinians held in Israel and 13 other detainees in other countries.



The hostages were held for a week in Entebbe airport terminal and eventually non-Jewish passengers and the crew were released. The hijacking led to the Israeli government sending an elite group of Commandos on a daring night raid on the airport terminal, which by chance had been designed by an Israeli firm.

Borrowing a Mercedes like President Amin, the Raid used C-130s in infiltrate and begin the daring 30 minute raid. After destroying Amin's Mig fighters at the airport, the Commandos hit the terminal. Of the 105 hostages left at the airport, three were killed and 10 wounded. 45 Ugandan soldiers were killed, 11 Migs destroyed, and one Israeli Commando was killed by a Ugandan sniper and 5 were wounded. All of the terrorists were killed.

GSG9 Raid in Somalia: Known as Operation Magic Fire, this action was taken on by the elite Grenzschutzgr 9 (Border Protection Group 9) or GSG9 for short. Formed as a result of the 1972 Munich tragedy, GSG9 is Germany's elite counter-terrorism unit.



On October 13, 1977 Lufthansa flight 181 on its way to Frankfurt, was hijacked by 4 Arab terrorists demanding the release of Red Army Faction members. With 84 hostages, the airliner was ferried to various countries, finally setting down in Mogadishu, Somalia. Commander of the operation, Ulrich Wegener, gathered a team which also included two British SAS members and pursued the hijacked airliner.



The Captain of the aircraft was killed, and GSG9 felt that time was running out for the passengers. Towards midnight a diversion was created, and GSG9 crawled to the aircraft with IR goggles. Using flash-bang devices for the first time, the aircraft was entered and all terrorists killed.

The Shoot: We will be creating two stages that will "set the scene" for these two daring and quick raids. You can expect to need at least 200 rounds for each time through the course. Eye Protection must be worn at all times during the shoot, and Hearing Protection as well, unless you are shooting suppressed.

Upon arrival you must check in at Registration. Cost to shoot is \$25.00 per round, and spectators are \$5.00 unless you are an Old Trails member. To join see www.otrpc.com. All proceeds go to the Old Trails Rifle and Pistol Club. Vendor displays are available.

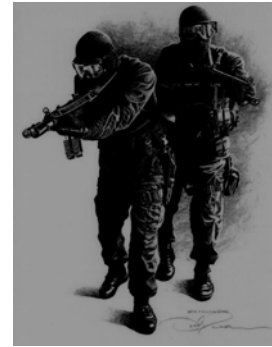
2008 ISSMC GREATEST SUBGUN RAIDS RULES!

NOTICE: The shoot will be run as a **COLD RANGE**. This means all firearms are to be unloaded, with chambers open and **NO** magazines inserted with a plastic tie secured through the ejection port and magazine well. Inserting a magazine is allowed **ONLY** when directed to do so by the Range Officer, **while on the firing line and ready to shoot**. Any Negligent Discharge (NDs) will result in the shooter being disqualified and asked to immediately leave the premises. There will be **NO** exceptions to this rule. The following is a list of rules, which will be **STRICTLY** enforced at the Shoot. **Any participant that sees any of these rules being violated should IMMEDIATELY notify Range Personnel.**

1. All competitors / spectators are required to wear hearing and eye protection while the range is hot.
2. Every competitor / spectator **MUST** sign a Liability Waiver and Disclaimer and a copy of these Rules immediately before entering the facility to shoot or observe.
3. There will be **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** allowed on the property, and their consumption before, during or after on range property **IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.
4. Guns must be fired in Full-Auto **ONLY**. Burst mode is **NOT** allowed for competition.
5. Guns may be altered, provided the alteration in no way interferes with the functioning of the manufacturer's safety devices.
6. Only pistol calibers (no more than 700 ft lbs. energy) are allowed - **NO TAPERED CASE CALIBERS**.
7. No armor piercing, incendiary, exploding, multiple projectiles, steel core, steel jacketed, or hollow point ammunition is to be used.
8. All firearms must be properly registered with the ATF in Washington D.C. A copy of the appropriate paperwork must be available for inspection before shooting is allowed.
9. More than one firearm may be shot, provided an additional entry fee is paid. All stages however **MUST** be shot with the same firearm for score. **ONLY THE FIRST RUN OF EACH CLASS WILL COUNT FOR AWARDS.**
10. No competitor will wear, use, or carry two or more firearms in the competition for this match.
11. If a malfunction cannot be cleared in a reasonable amount of time, a competitor will make the firearm safe, then at the direction of the Range Officer, move to a designated safe area to make any repairs.
12. The Match Organizer and Match Coordinator's are the final authorities for this match, upon proper presentation of evidence, may at their discretion, disqualify (DQ) any competitor for a violation of the rules.
13. The range will be operated as a COLD range. All firearms are to be unloaded, chambers clear, and have no magazine inserted except at the firing point, when the competitor is directed to do so by the Range Office. **ALL FIREARMS MUST HAVE PLASTIC TIES SECURED THROUGH THE CHAMBER BEFORE THE FIREARM IS MOVED BETWEEN STAGES OR BETWEEN STAGES AND VEHICLE.**
14. All firearms must be rendered **SAFE** and slung (over the shoulder and muzzle down) or cased when moving on or off the range or between stages on the range.
15. A competitor shall present a dispute to the Match Organizer and Match Coordinator within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the dispute. Their decision is final.

As a shooter and/or spectator (hereafter both referred to as a "Participant") of the Indiana State Submachine Gun Championship, I understand, agree and attest to the following:

1. I have read and understand the Rules contained on the back of this page and agree to adhere by them.
2. I understand and agree that being a Participant at a shooting match such as this event, can be inherently dangerous. The use of deadly firearms in such activity places myself and others at risk. I hereby accept all responsibility for my own actions and the actions of others whether deemed negligent or not. I will hold the Old Trails Rifle & Pistol Club and the individuals who organized, coordinated, and worked the event blameless and harmless for any accident, death, injury, or mishap caused by my own actions or the actions of others while at this event.
3. If minor(s) are accompanying me, I attest that I am their parent or legal guardian, and accept full responsibility for them while at this event, and assume all responsibilities under point #2 on their behalf.
4. I understand that whenever steel targets are utilized, shrapnel, steel, lead shavings and particulate, and other particles and projectiles may ricochet, bounce back, or become airborne into the spectator's and shooter's areas. I further understand that **EYE PROTECTION IS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES AND HEARING PROTECTION IS REQUIRED AROUND THE SHOOTING AREAS.** I agree to hold the Old Trails Rifle and Pistol Club and the individuals who organized, coordinated, and worked the event blameless and harmless for any injury due to ricochets and any damage to eyes, vision, breathing, or hearing due to being a Participant at this event.
5. I understand that the weather is not controllable and agree not to hold Old Trails Rifle and Pistol Club, or the event coordinators / workers responsible for Acts of God.
6. I understand that the Old Trails Rifle & Pistol Club and the event coordinators and workers are not responsible for any theft, vandalism, or loss occurring at the event.
7. I understand that the Old Trails Rifle & Pistol Club, the event organizers / coordinators and workers assume NO LIABILITY for any theft, damage, accidents, injuries, shooting (whether accidental or intentional), or unfortunate death which may occur during the event. I agree to hold the Old Trails Rifle & Pistol Club, event organizers / coordinators and workers blameless and harmless in the event of such an incident.
8. I attest that if acting as a shooter, my firearm is legally owned and properly registered with the ATF under the guidelines and laws of the United States of America. I am fully responsible for its safe use and operating condition and accept full responsibility for it and its use while participating at the event and while on the event grounds.

Shoot is limited to 150 runs with 90 on Saturday and 60 on Sunday. **THE MAXIMUM RUNS PER DAY IS TWO, THREE OVER THE TWO DAY EVENT.**
